(Traditional) Comedians – those who made their names on such shows as “The Comedians” “Opportunity Knocks” and “New Faces”

Johnnie Casson (A)	The comedians comedian, from Yorkshire simply a superb stand up comedian.
Mick Miller (A)	The Max Wall lookalike and as fresh today as 30 years ago.
Duggie Brown (A)	Known for his infamous parrott sketch, now an equally popular actor
David Copperfield (A)	From BBC’s “Three of a Kind” with Lenny Henry and Tracey Ulman
Stu Francis (A)	Star of the New Crackerjack, he could “crush a grape”
Norman Collier (A)	The man behind the “broken microphone” routine. Clever comedian.
Jimmy Cricket (A)	The simple Irishman with the wellie. Incredibly popular comedian still today.
Bernard Manning (A)	Need we say more. Not quite as controversial these days as he once was.
Keith Harris / Orville (A)	The worlds most famous duck and his assistant, Keith. Adult or family shows.
Roger De Courcey (B)	He of Nookie Bear fame. Excellent comedy entertainer.
Billy Pearce (B)	Yorkshire’s finest after Johnnie Casson. Cheeky comedian. Panto favourite
Roy Walker (B)	Original host of “Catchphrase” Genial Irish story teller / comedian.
Stan Boardman (B)	One of Liverpool’s biggest comedy names. “Anti-German!”
Frank Carson (B)	Irelands and the World’s funniest comedian. According to Frank.
The Grumbleweeds (B)	Still one of the most original and well known comedy showbands.
Duncan Norvelle (B)	The camp star of “chase me” fame. A true comedy entertainer.
Tom O Connor (C)	Host of countless TV quiz shows, and regarded as one of the very best dinner comedians.
Bobby Davro (C)	Topical / Traditional Zany comedy entertainer and impressionist.
Richard Digance (C)	Cockney comedy entertainer. Comedy songs and gags. A firm fav in the South.
Jethro (D)	The larger than life comedy legend, from the South West of England
Jim Davison (E)	The Cheeky Cockney. As known off stage as he is on, where he is simply brilliant.
